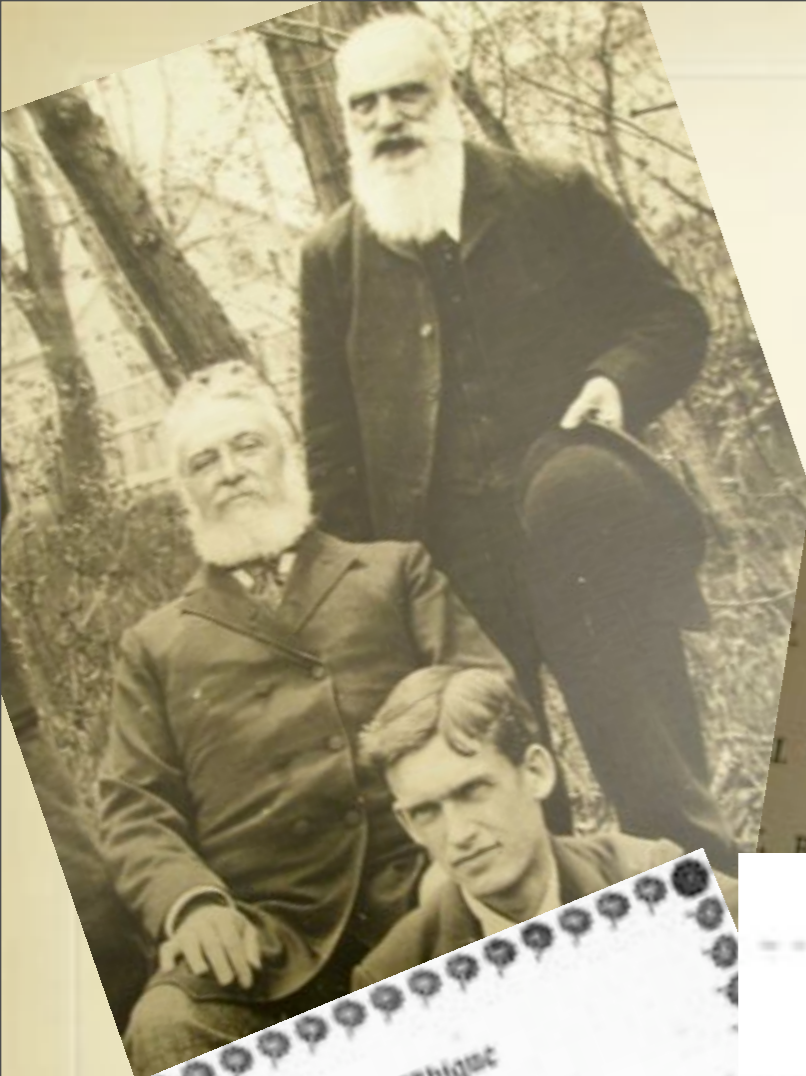


BUILDING A “HOME PLACE”: INSTITUTIONAL BACKGROUND

THE LM MONTGOMERY INSTITUTE

- Established in 1993/1994 to foster “informed appreciation” of Montgomery’s cultural legacy.
- Initial focus on educational activity -- ESL-Japan; LMM International Conferences.
- In recent years, increasing attention given to research collections.

THE LMMI COLLECTIONS

DEVELOP ...

- “Stand-alone” treasures: artifacts and memorabilia (kimono, watch) and a few early/rare editions
- Current editions of Montgomery-related works: reference works, new editions, new translations, etc.
- Early 2000s: several small but significant collections of early/inscribed Montgomery editions donated
- 2006 - present: The Ryrie-Campbell Collection

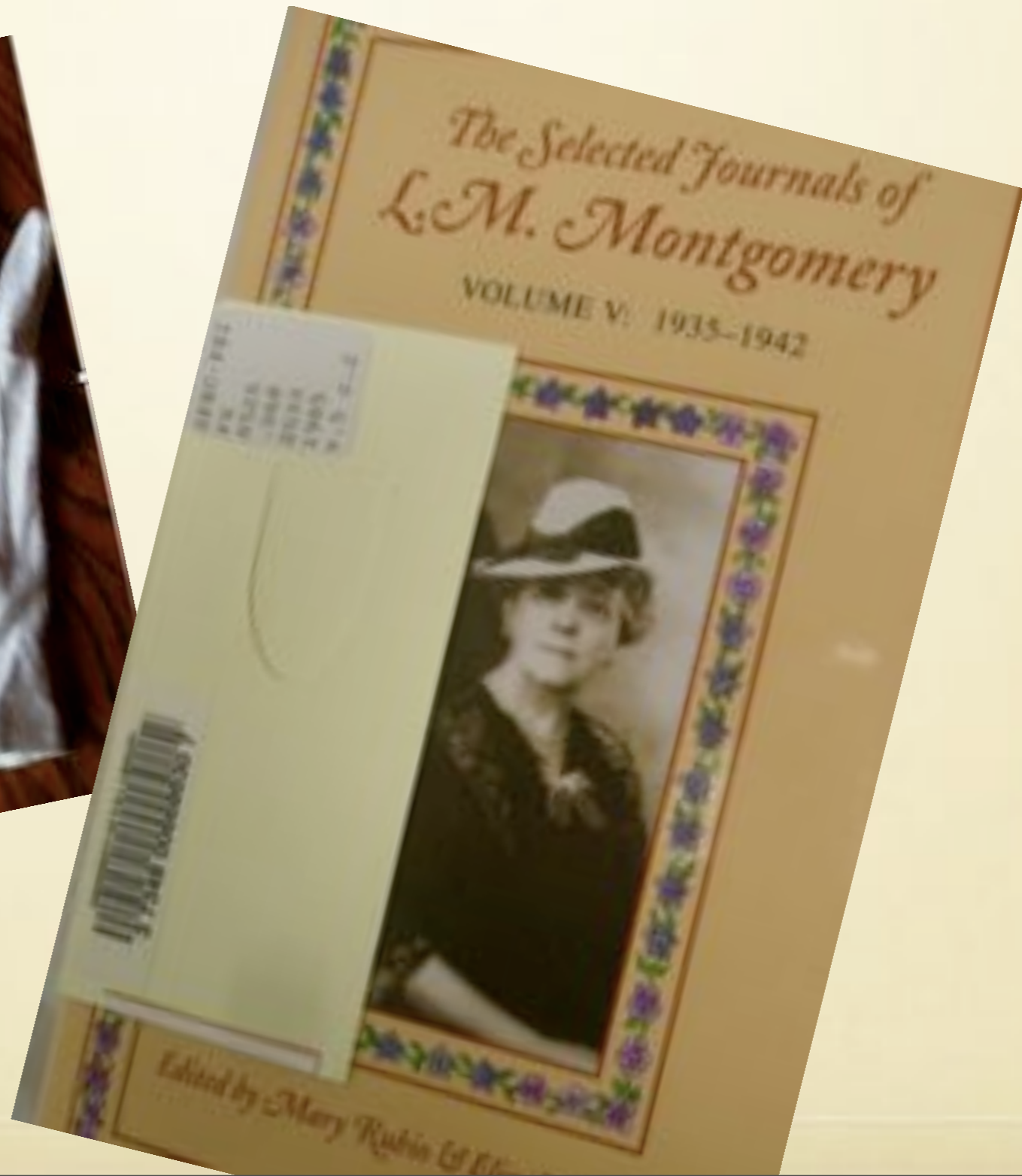

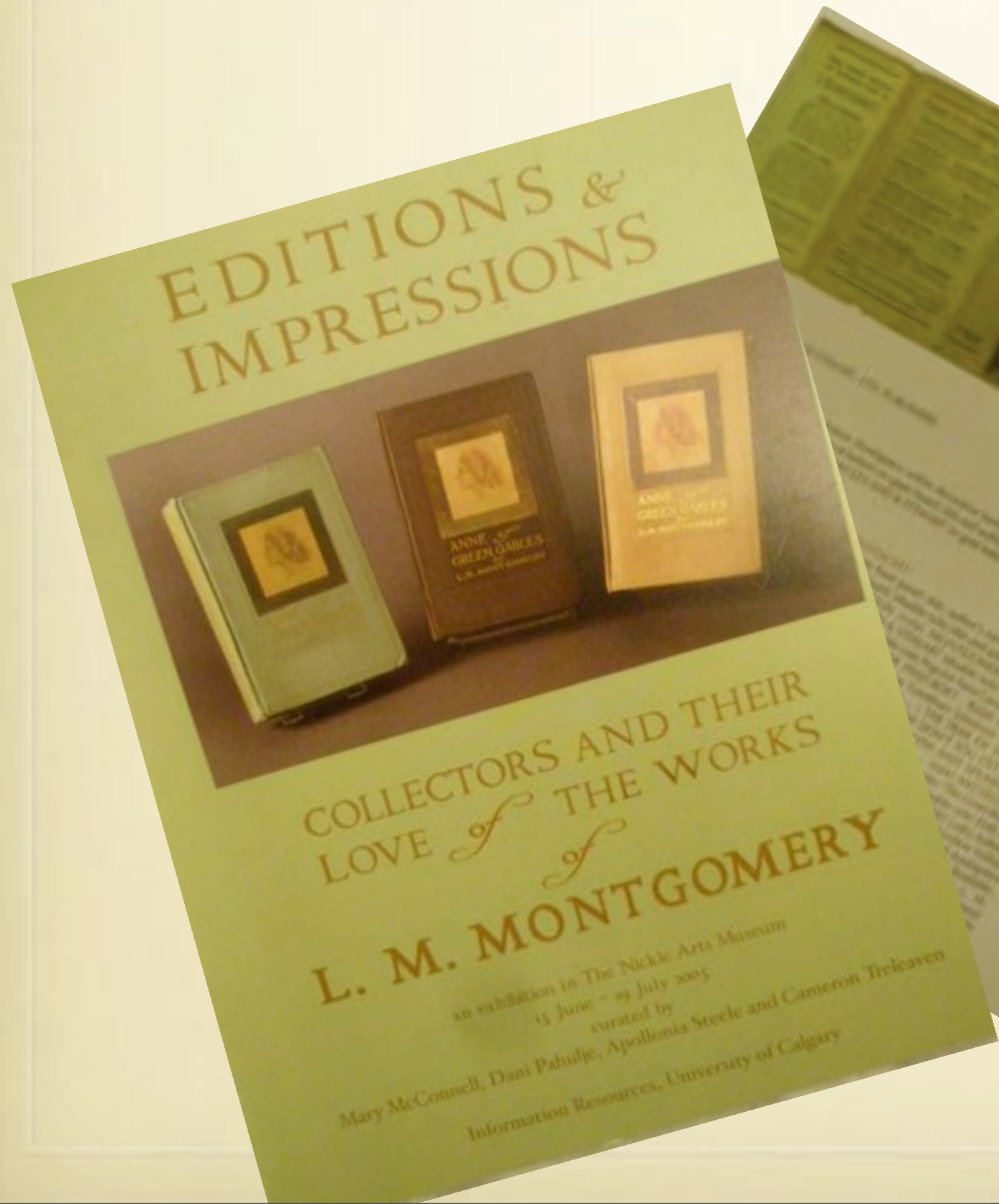

ARRANGEMENT & CATALOGUING


- Some collections not well-served by traditional library arrangement (author/title/date); for many elements of Ryrie-Campbell, for example, better to arrange by publishers;
- Also need to consider non-book materials;
- As for cataloguing: well, there's basic inventory/shelf-lists, then there's CATALOGUING ...

DIGITIZATION

- No panacea: still expensive and time-consuming to do well, and can't substitute for the original, but ...
- A powerful way to share words and images, especially with distance users, and can protect originals from excess handling;
- Also offers great possibilities for in-text searching, textual analyses, thanks to optical character recognition (OCR)
